The Nuts and Bolts:

What's the Plan? Elizabeth's New Life Center (ENLC) is planning an expansion to meet the growing need for pregnancy resource services in high abortion zip code areas of Dayton and Cincinnati where babies' lives are threatened daily by abortion. We have already selected the perfect location for the Dayton site; the building is right next door to a new high school in the North Dixie area and is near a metropolitan housing neighborhood called Northland Village which has a high number of pregnancies and abortions. The area was heavily damaged by the recent Memorial Day tornadoes and is home to many low-income families.



The other intended location is the Mt. Healthy neighborhood of Cincinnati. Although we have not yet determined the exact location for this site, this zip code has the HIGHEST number of abortions in the entire SW Ohio region. Last year alone, there were 163 abortions in the area with no pregnancy resource center nearby.
