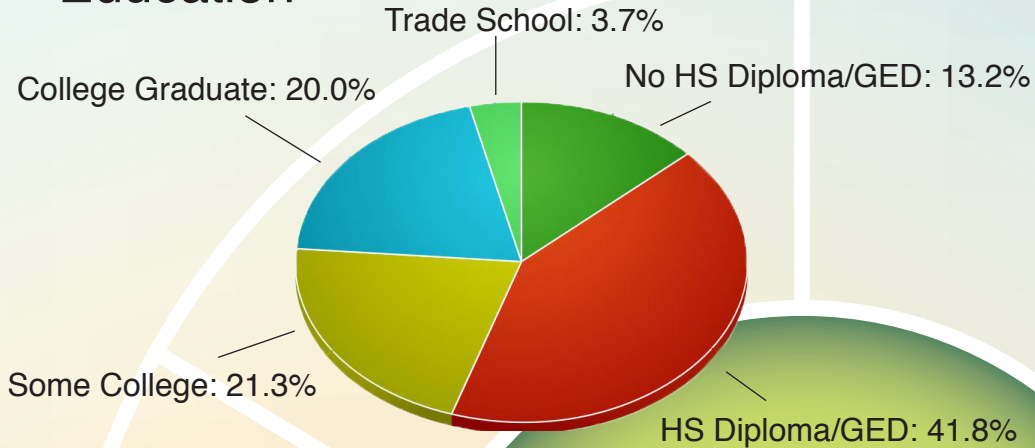

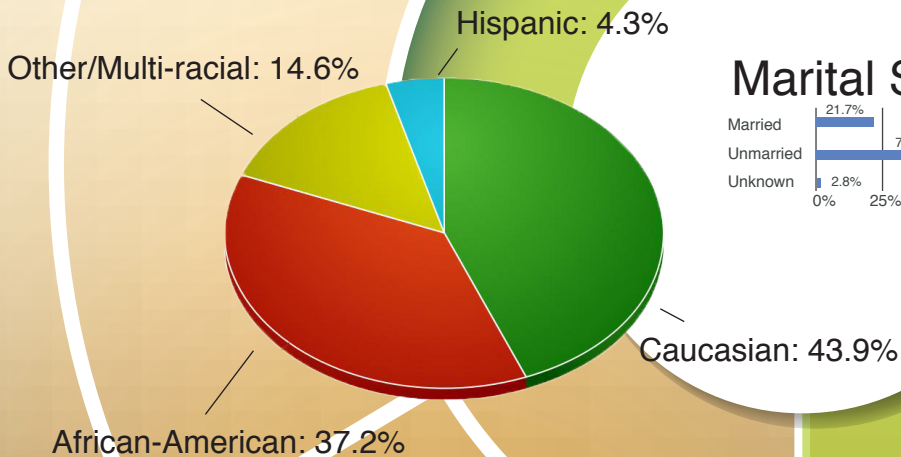

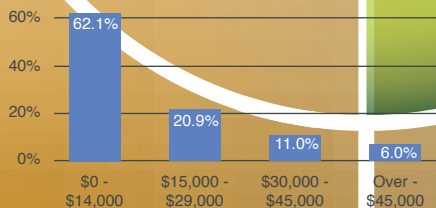
## Education



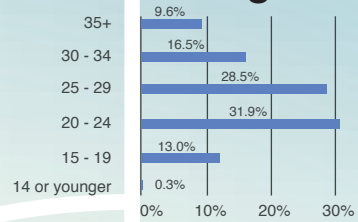
## Ethnicity



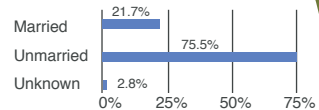
## Income



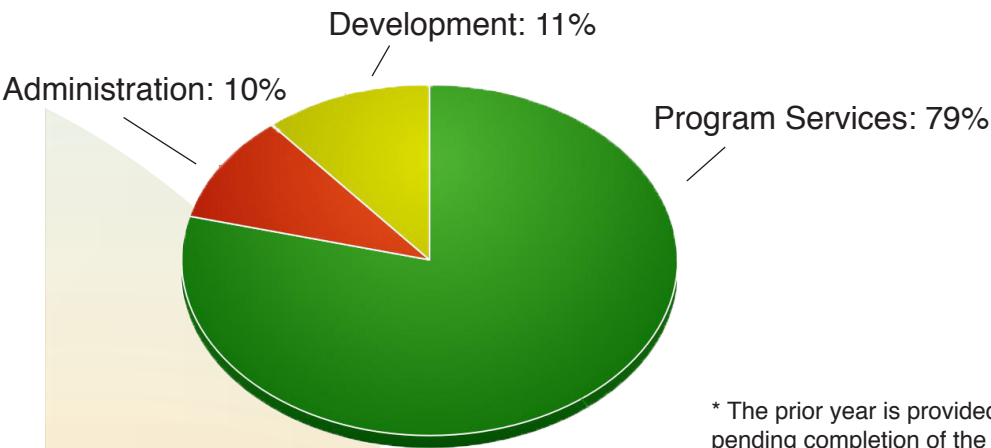
## Age



## Marital Status



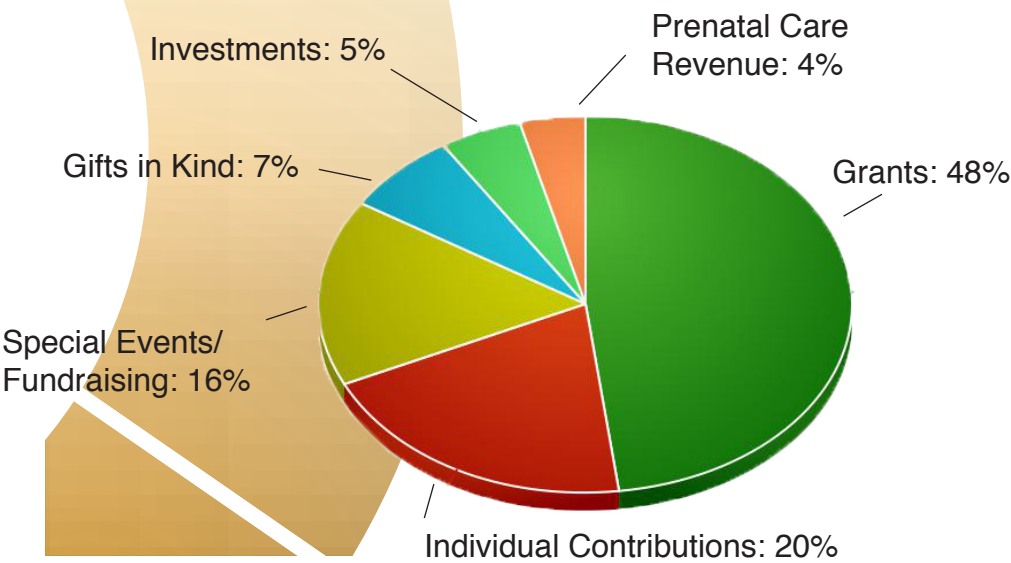
# Distribution Of Expenses\*
