ENLC operates eight Women's Centers throughout Southwestern Ohio. We are strategically located in Dayton, East Dayton, Kettering, Lebanon, Forest Park, N. Dixie, and Sidney, with our newest center in Mt. Healthy, Ohio. We operate "Baby Boutiques" in five of our locations.





## Distribution Of Expenses<sup>\*</sup>


Development: 11%
