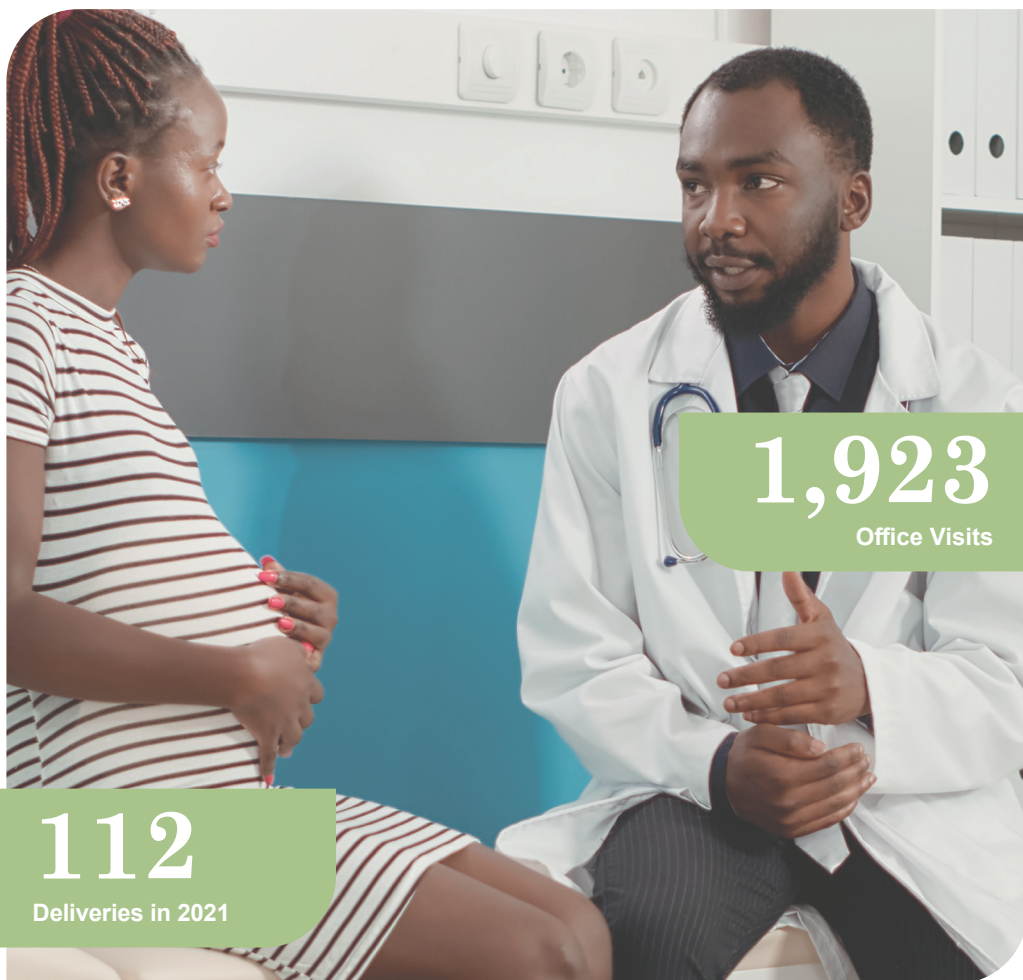

## *Holy Family Prenatal Care*

Holy Family Prenatal Care provides comprehensive prenatal care to Medicaid-eligible families throughout the Miami Valley. Through our “Strong Start” program, we cover prenatal care costs until Medicaid coverage can be secured. The “Sweet Dreams” program provides new cribs to patients who complete a series of educational requirements.

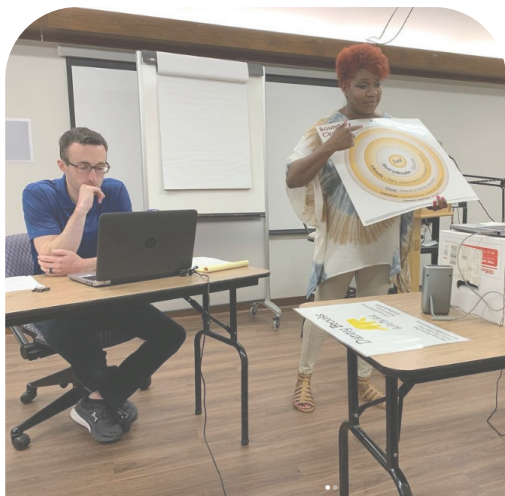

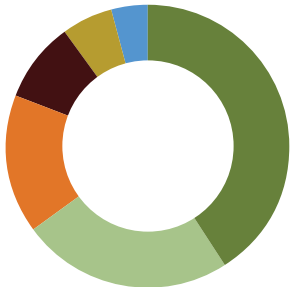


# 2021 DISTRIBUTION OF EXPENSES

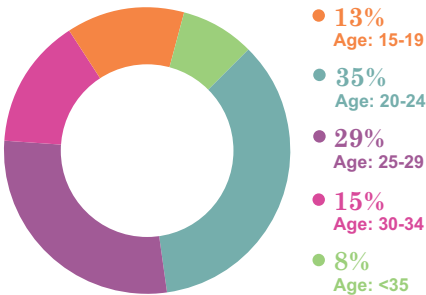
# 2021 SOURCES OF INCOME



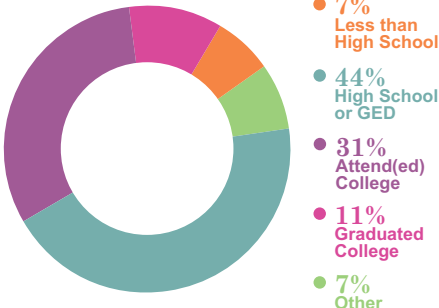

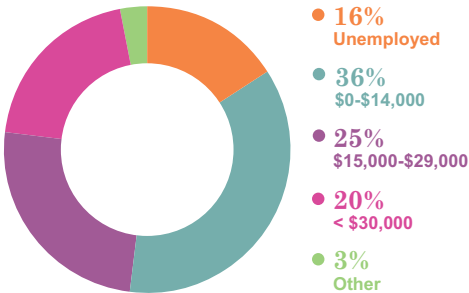

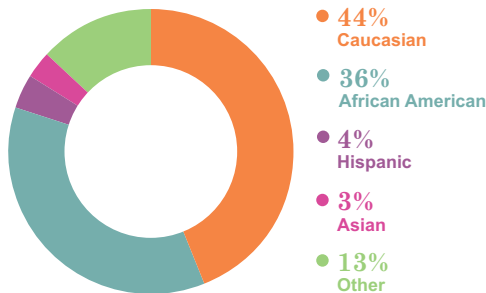
