




New Center - Western Hills



Holy Family Prenatal Care provides comprehensive prenatal care to Medicaid-eligible families throughout the Miami Valley. Through our "Strong Start" program, we cover prenatal care costs until Medicaid coverage can be secured. The "Sweet Dreams" program provides new cribs to patients who complete a series of educational requirements.







41 Patients received a new crib. 14% Of new patients utilized our Strong Start program.






