From Vivian's Desk The Overturning: **ROE V. WADE**

he first half of this year has brought so much transition to our nation, which has directly impacted Elizabeth's New Life Center. From navigating through the end of a pandemic to shifting gears after the overturn of Roe v. Wade, we have all been affected individually and collectively. These changes, particularly the latter, have affected ENLC and have **created a greater need for Pregnancy Resource Centers to help women who are afraid and are not certain how to handle an unexpected pregnancy.**

OHIO ENACTING THE HEARTBEAT BILL

With the overturn of Roe, Ohio's Heartbeat Bill, which bans all abortions in Ohio after a heartbeat is detected, could bring an end to legal abortion in Ohio. The Heartbeat Bill will likely be challenged and will take time to enact, while its success will be dependent upon the willingness of state and local officials to enforce them.

SUPPORTING THE WOMEN IN NEED OF AID

ENLC will continue to provide free services including consultations, ultrasounds, and material assistance, as we are now needed more than ever before. We are also offering support services and mentoring to male clients, the babies father, through our newly incorporated men's ministry. In addition, we extend couple's counseling opportunities to clients who are interested in strengthening their relationships and considering marriage.

Taking the lead in this fight against abortion and saving the lives of the innocent babies in Southwest Ohio, can only continue through your support and partnership with us. **The overturn of Roe is just the beginning of the many victories ahead for the unborn.** Thank you for all you do, because we could not do this work without you.

Kettering Med Abortion Clinic Closes It's Doors

After many years of prayer, ENLC gives praise to God for the imminent closure of the Dayton abortion mill, Women's Med Center. According to a statement issued by Ohio Right to Life on August 30th, the facility had halted abortions at their Ohio location in June, following the enactment of Ohio's Heartbeat law, but had referred patients to their location in Indiana. "Due to Indiana's recently enacted pro-life law going into effect **on September 15th, Women's Med will now be closing both locations permanently**," the statement reports.

ENLC established Women's Center-Kettering across the street to reach women seeking abortions at Women's Med's Ohio location. By giving moms the opportunity to see and bond with their babies in the womb through ultrasound and providing support such as parenting classes and infant care items, this center successfully helped some of the women headed for abortion to choose life for their babies instead. We rejoice in the closing, but the work to save lives continues. ENLC will continue to serve women and men experiencing unexpected pregnancies at their Women's Centers throughout Southwest Ohio, helping to equip and empower them as parents. We thank God for His faithfulness, the laws in the land reflecting His will, and you, His people for your continued support.

GIT TAKES TWO Supporting The Fathers Of The Unborn

Elizabeth's New Life Center's Men's Program has served more than 2,000 men since its inception in 2020. The men's ministry provides consultation for each father that comes to one of our centers through Jarid, our Men's Coordinator, or a male volunteer. If a father is abortionminded, the consultant will go over all options available to the father and consult with him on his decision for his unborn child.

Once a man leaves the session, the consultant will follow up with every male through text message, offering free services and support. Every father can participate in "Earn While You Learn," to accumulate 'baby bucks' for taking classes on fatherhood, nutrition, child development, relationship skills, child safety and more. Expectant fathers may participate in "Dads With Direction," an in-person class offered in various centers. In class the men can talk about issues dads experience while learning they are not alone in facing the challenges of an unexpected pregnancy. According to the men's coordinator, Jarid, "Many men simply need another guy to talk to about the situation he's in, whether good or bad. It takes two to make a baby, so why only offer services and assistance to one parent?" Jarid adds:

"The men's program in Women Centers of Ohio is dedicated to giving men value by letting them know they matter and are just as important as the mother of their child." Currently, ENLC is looking for a part-time male consultant for our Southern Ohio region as we are continuing to build a team to help serve our clients. OUR NEW BUILDING

Marriage Works! Ohio Moves to a New Facility

Marriage Works! Ohio has moved to a new building to house Youth Development Services and Marriage Enrichment Programs. This facility is located on Riverton Dr. in Dayton and was newly renovated to provide services for students in grades 7 through 12 through our healthy relationship curriculums, which include Go For the Gold, Relationships Under Construction, Stuck in the Middle, and Aspire as well as the Marriage Enrichment Programs.

The Marriage Enrichment Program offers programs and services for dating, engaged, and married couples. These programs consist of Couples Mentorship, which teaches relationship skills and practical guidance in navigating marriage; Couples Therapy, which strengthens relationship skills and rebuilds broken relationships; and Rekindling the Heart, which is a marriage enrichment program for married and engaged couples, which can be taken as a 7-week or 12-week session. 

They both nervously agreed to have an ultrasound and soon after learned Ellen had two amniotic sacs; she was carrying twins. Ellen and Brad were so excited, because Brad too, is a twin. They both were overjoyed and agreed they wanted to keep the babies. Both soon-to-be parents were very concerned about being able to afford to raise twins. The couple was encouraged to take "Earn While You Learn" classes to be able to earn Baby Bucks to shop in our Baby Boutiques for their baby needs.
